Goals

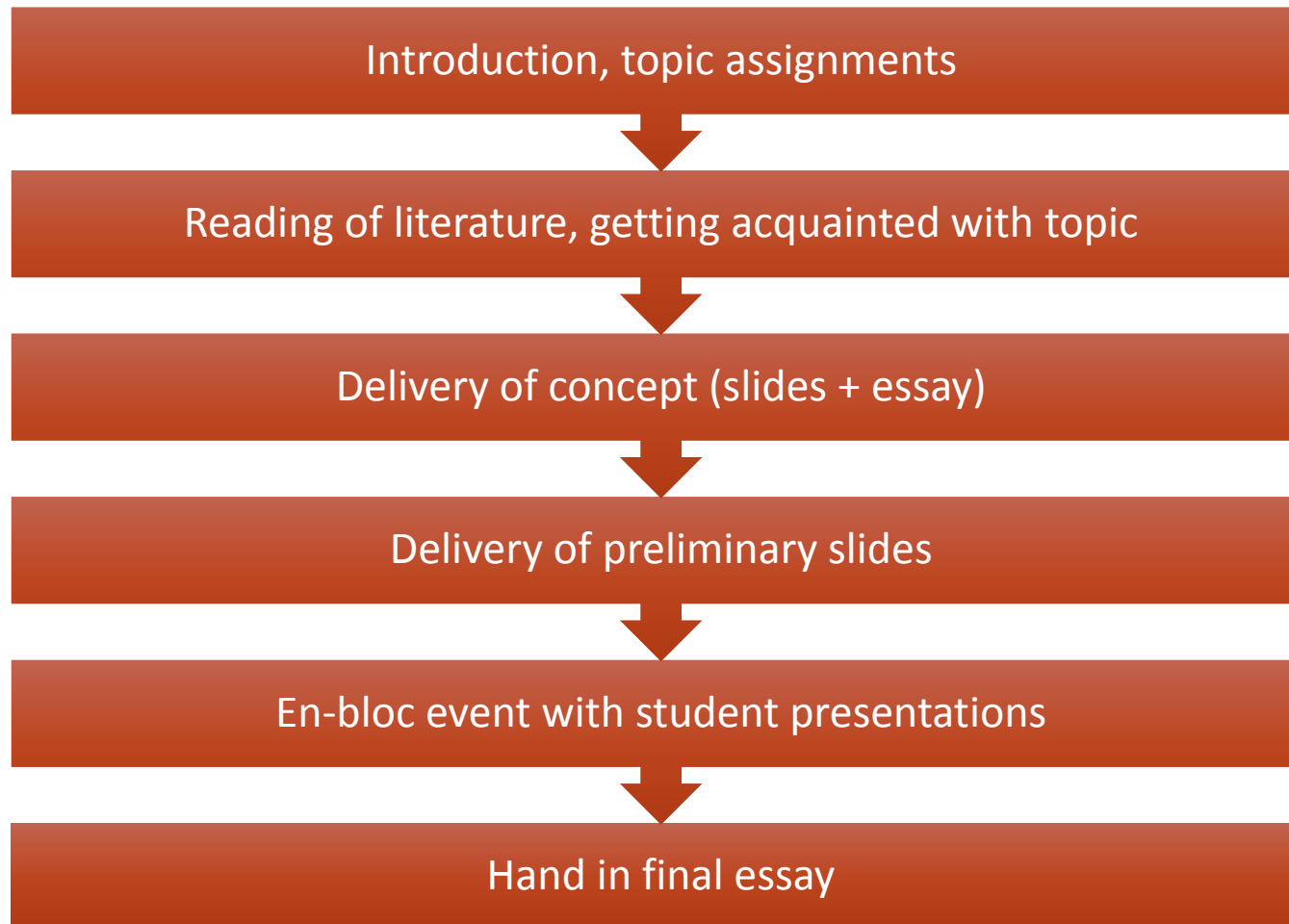
- Each student will get his own topic

Goals

- Giving a scientific presentation (in English)
 - 20 min presentation + 5-10 min discussion
 - PowerPoint template available, but you may use your own one ..

- Writing a scientific essay (in English)
 - 4-5 pages including title page, images, refs, ...
 - Essay **must be in IEEE style!**
 - Template (IEEE style) will be provided -> link on the course website
